OPTIONAL ANUGA ADD-ON

About

The cost of the RFA International Tour includes free entrance tickets and welcome packages to Anuga. The cost does *NOT* include accommodations for the days prior to the Tour. Attendees who arrive early for Anuga will need to make their own hotel and food accommodations. Transportation is free throughout Cologne within the [VRS net](#) during Anuga with your show ticket.

For those wishing to arrive in Cologne prior to the Tour to take part in Anuga, we suggest making arrangements *IMMEDIATELY* at one of the following hotels:

- In Cologne: Savoy, <https://www.savoy.de/en>
This hotel option is much more costly, but convenient for visiting Anuga.
- Althoff Grandhotel Schloss Bensberg, <https://www.schlossbensberg.com/de>
This castle is a 5-star hotel is located east of the city. Public transportation is available and within 25 minutes of Anuga. At no extra cost, attendees can take train no. 1 to Bf Deutz/Lanxess Arena and arrive at the south entrance of the show.
- In Dusseldorf: Hotel Stadt Munchen, <https://www.hotel-stadt-muenchen.de/>
This is the least expensive option.
Transportation from Anuga in Cologne until Langenfeld is free with S-Bahn or Regional Express; to get to Dusseldorf, the cost is approximately \$10 round trip and will take 35-50 minutes.
